FSILG Facilities Renewal

Our goal: To make it easy and affordable for organizations to make their houses safer for students.

- FSILG Facilities Renewal Committee Joint AILG/DSL committee
- Identified potential life-safety improvements for <u>community-wide</u> <u>projects</u> (from Arup assessments and BSF experience)
- Expenses covered at 75% by the IRDF as safety improvements
- Program concept endorsed by AILG and IRDF Grant Advisory Board, and IRDF allocation approved by the MIT Treasurer



FSILG Life-Safety Improvement Program

Identified <u>life-safety systems improvement opportunities</u> common to most houses:

Phase 1: Egress doors and hardware

Phase 2: Fire alarm upgrades

Phase 3: Sprinkler system upgrades

Phase 1: Egress Doors and Hardware

- Pilots: Beta Theta Pi, Sigma Kappa, Theta Chi
 - Actual expenses were close to estimates
 - Limiting scope of work to hardware and carpentry
- Project Management by FCI (100% covered by IRDF)
- Collaborating closely with organizations to finalize scope of work
- Group 1: Epsilon Theta, Fenway House, Nu Delta, Phi Beta Epsilon, Pi Lambda Phi, pika, Sigma Chi, Student House, Theta Xi
