FSILG Facilities Renewal – *Remember this???*

- FSILG Facilities Renewal Committee Joint AILG/DSL committee approved as AILG ad-hoc committee in November 2018.
- Committee Charge: To promote and support implementation of the physical renewal of the Fraternities, Sororities and Independent Living Groups (FSILGs) to ensure they remain vital and vibrant resources to MIT students by implementing the the recommendations of the 2018 facilities assessments.
- Focused on identifying potential <u>community-wide projects</u>
 - Utilize economy of scale
 - Identify professional Project Manager to oversee entire program

FSILG Life-Safety Improvement Program (FLIP)

- Identified life-safety improvement opportunities common to almost all houses:
 - -> Doors and egress, fire alarms, sprinkler systems
- Conducted cost estimation
- Issued RFP and interviewed candidates for Project Manager
- Funding
 - -> IRDF covering project manager expense
 - -> IRDF covering project cost at safety percentage: 75% IRDF, 25% house
- Our goal: To make it easy and affordable for organizations
- Our ask: Please let us know if you would like to be an <u>early adopter</u> for doors and egress (Phase 1) program
