FSILG Facilities Assessment

The purpose of this project is to advance a shared understanding the needs for physical renewal of FSILGs to ensure they remain a vital and vibrant element of the MIT community.

After a successful pilot this summer with Delta Tau Delta, Sigma Kappa, and the No. 6 Club, the goal is to extend this effort to the entire FSILG community during this academic year. Each FSILG will receive a report that prioritizes core systems deficiencies and needs and projects cost for renewal that will inform near and long-term planning and budgeting for each FSILG.

All FSILGs housing students are expected to participate, and contribute \$7,500 per organization towards the cost of the assessment. This information would form the basis of the physical conditions section of the peer review by the AILG Accreditation Committee. The AILG Facilities will also be a resource for all FSILGs.

FSILGs may also use the report as important information for a fundraising campaign, with which MIT, DSL, and the AILG Finance Committee can assist as requested. There will a spring 2018 fundraising seminar based of what people have learned.
