Here are **notes from the June 7 AILG IT Committee Meeting** in W59. This was the first in-person meeting for quite some time.

It was also an abbreviated meeting with just four specific agenda items:

1) Meeting schedule for the next academic year.

Our meetings for the 2023-2024 academic year are planned for the following Wednesdays at 2PM in the W59 Conference Room - September 13 and November 15 in 2023: February 14, April 17, and June 12, 2024.

2) Update the VOIP options description.

The group reviewed the text of <https://ailg.mit.edu/fsilg-voip-information>. A few edits were suggested by Scott Klemm and others. These are now incorporated in the on-line document.

3) Decide on the network fees for the academic next year,

All network inspection fees of \$400 per year will be rebated this year because all inspections were scheduled without undue delay. The group kept the annual fee at \$2,100 for next year. Because inspection compliance has been excellent no *initial* inspection fees will be assessed next year. If any FSILGs delay or fail inspections, the \$400 fee may be assessed.

4) Finalize the AILG IT Committee Annual Report.
